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Useful tables and figures should not duplicate the text. They should supplement and clarify the text, otherwise, minimize the use of tables and figures. All tables and figures should be inserted into the text as appropriate. Overlarge tables and figures are discouraged. All tables must be formatted using the specific 'table' creation function in MS Word. Any other visual representation such as charts, diagrams, graphs and photos should be indicated as a figure.
